

<u>Planting in the Garden</u>	Working in teams, students plan their garden and plant fall vegetables while learning what different plants need in order to grow.	October
<u>Making Garden Signs</u>	Students make garden and plant identification signs for their garden.	October
<u>An Apple a Day</u>	Students learn about different varieties of apples, make apple juice, and devise their own methods of extracting juice.	October
<u>Eating in Season</u>	Do locally grown foods really taste better than those grown far away? Is there a distinct difference between varieties of the same fruit or vegetable?	November
<u>Eat a Rainbow</u>	Students will learn about health benefits of eating a variety of fruits and Vegetables	November
<u>Egg Investigation</u>	Students investigate different colored eggs and compare differences between farmers market and grocery store eggs.	November
<u>In a Pickle</u>	Students conduct an experiment to determine what fraction of vinegar is needed to safely preserve pickles. Students will use math skills to determine volumes needed based on a ratio.	December
<u>Forcing Bulbs</u>	Students will learn the process of forcing bulbs indoors and gain skills in patience and delayed gratification.	December
<u>Kitchen Scrap Gardening</u>	Students will learn about sustainable living, recycling and reusing in a creative, fun way	January
<u>Plant Parts Salad</u>	Students can harvest their different salad greens and create a delicious snack together	January
<u>Building a Terrarium</u>	Students will gain an understanding of the water cycle	February
<u>Planting in the Garden</u>	Students will begin preparing their garden for spring vegetables	March
<u>Poetry in the Garden</u>	Students use their five senses to observe the garden and record what they hear, feel, smell, see and taste through writing a variety of poems	April
<u>All About Worms</u>	Students will learn about the life cycle of worms and how they benefit the garden and farming	May
<u>Pressed Flower And Leaves</u>	Students will use the plant press and create works of art	May
